8 compass points – North, north east, east, south east, south, south west, west, north west.



Physical and human features of Oldham.

Physical: A natural feature such as rivers, hills, moors

Human: Built by humans such as bridges and roads.

Land usage – leisure (park), commercial (shops), residential (housing), industrial (mills), agricultural (farmland)

Migration/asylum seekers – Why do people come to live in Oldham? How do they feel? Hopes, dreams and fears.

Citizen – A resident of a place (town or city)

Migration – Movement from one place to another

Asylum seeker – Person who has been forced to leave their country through fear, war or violence.

Compass – Shows direction using different points

What can different materials do and how does this make them useful?

Material is a matter from which something can be made. Materials can include, glass, wood, plastic, cloth and metal among others.

Properties – Characteristics of a material for example, soft, strong, smooth, rough, flexible, rigid. The property can be measured, felt or seen.

Properties of rocks:

- **Igneous:** formed by the cooling and hardening of magma or lava from a volcano



- **Metamorphic:** Formed by pressure deep under the Earth's surface.



- **Sedimentary:** Are made when sand, mud and pebbles get laid down in layers over time.



- **Permeable:** Allows liquid to pass through.

- **Impermeable:** Does not allow liquid to pass through.

- **Absorb:** Can soak up and retain liquid.
