Carnival - a festival in Brazil that happens once every year.

Favela - the name for the shantytowns found in Brazil. A shantytown is on the edge of a city and has many cheaply made houses.

Amazon River - a huge river in Brazil.

Climate - this means the typical weather we expect in a place.

Equator - The equator is a line (that is not real) drawn around the Earth. The equator is halfway between the North Pole and the South Pole. Countries closer to the equator are hotter.

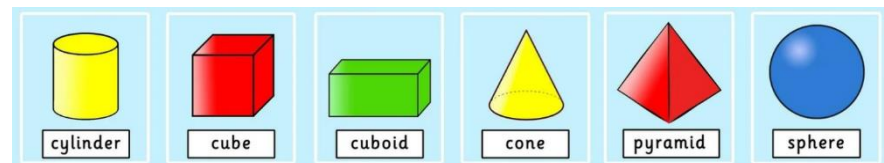

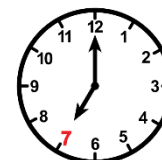
